- **Age:** Clinics are open to both youth and adults, starting from ages 6 and above
- **Equipment:** ALL adaptive equipment will be provided, including carts

Clinic Offerings

Beginner Clinics:

These clinics support new or returning golfers, including those recovering from on-site disabilities, by offering a welcoming space to learn core skills with one-on-one volunteer guidance. Participants practice on the putting green, driving range, and a beginner-friendly 9-hole birdie course.

These clinics help golfers build skills while socializing in a supportive setting, playing in pairs on a 9-hole executive course with volunteer guidance. Most participants can expect to complete 5-9 holes with minimal assistance.
